Topic:

Starting an E-RIM Program

Session Overview:

Many of us in the RIM industry have to deal with the electronic records through various business situations, and often do not have the necessary tools or systems, which poses a challenge. This meeting is a great opportunity to find answers to those burning questions regarding how to deal with your electronic records.

Peggy Milovina-Meyer, HP's Global Records Manager will share her experiences in launching the E-RIM program. It'll be a great opportunity to see first hand how HP has dealt with the challenge of electronic records, and how it might benefit you.

Speaker Bio:

Peggy Milovina-Meyer is currently Hewlett Packard's Global Records Manager responsible for developing an enterprise-wide records management program that adheres to regulatory compliance, tax production, and litigation discovery requirements in over 170 countries. During her tenure at Hewlett Packard, she has worked in tax, global trade, supply chain, IT, and legal departments, developing and implementing key process improvements and software solutions. She currently oversees a global network of over 4,000 employees tasked with records management responsibilities by region, country, and business process. By directive from HP's General Counsel, she is involved with a multi-year project to automate the management of structured and unstructured records for over 320,000 employees with a multi-faceted team from HP software and HP IT. She currently serves on the RIM Forum with fifteen other major global companies, influencing standards and initiatives for records management.
