MY BIO (Bruce E. Bailey, CRM)

Bruce E. Bailey has been the Director of Records for the Utah Department of Corrections since 1993. He is in charge of enterprise wide records management for this state agency. We apply the Utah records law, which is named GRAMA (the Government Records Access and Management Act). Although we are not a Covered Entity under HIPAA, this regulation has played a large part in records issues for Mr. Bailey, he was appointed by the Governor to the state's HIPAA Preemption Taskforce. We keep informed and involved in all records issues in the state, with an emphasis on criminal justice/law enforcement records. This involvement in CJ records resulted in Mr. Bailey acquiring a second Bachelors degree in 2002, this time in Criminal Justice and Corrections.

An earlier series of Degrees with a BA and MA completed and an ABD status on the doctorate, in Political Science lead Mr. Bailey to become the Senior Research Analyst of Utah Foundation, a non-profit government and tax research organization.

The combination of 11 years viewing government and records from an academic perspective and the 12, plus, years from the viewpoint of the bureaucrat has provided Mr. Bailey with unique insights into records management issues in government, especially in the criminal justice system.

Mr. Bailey finds a lot of joy in records management and the issues to be intriguing. This enthusiasm, recently, lead to the completion of the CRM and involvement in HIPAA compliance for the state of Utah.
